

reviseOmatic – Teachers' Guide

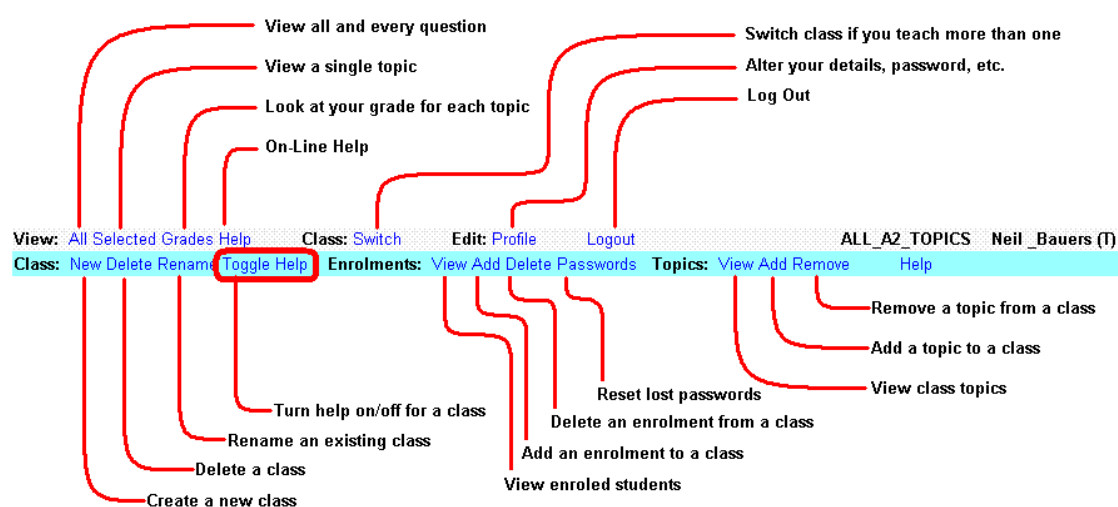
Register: Register on the reviseOmatic site and get your students to register as well.

Teacher Upgrade: Now send an email to Neil to get yourself upgraded to "Teacher" status. This allows you to create and manage classes.

Create a Class: Now create one or more classes. As over 40 schools or colleges use reviseOmatic, it's a good idea if your class names also identify your school. All my class names begin with enorf.ac.uk as this uniquely identifies my school.

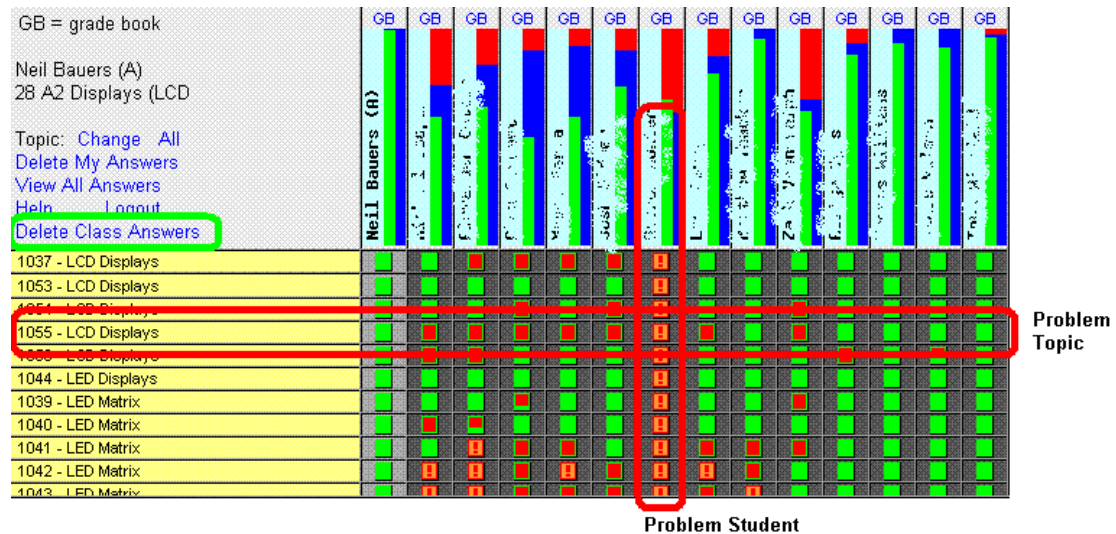
Enrol Students: Add students to your class. They need to have registered first using the registration form.

Set Homework: Add one or more topics to the class. This highlights the questions and makes it obvious they are due for completion as a homework task by a deadline.

The homework is self marking so the teacher can do more useful work instead of marking.

Monitor Progress: Orange or red indicates a problem. A red column is a student who is having trouble getting the answers right. An orange column is a student who has not done the work. A red row shows a difficult topic or perhaps you taught it badly.



Set a Test: Use "Delete Class Answers" (green highlight) and get your students to re-do the topic under test conditions. Toggle help **OFF** before they take the test. (see the red highlight on the previous page.)

After the test, collect the grades before toggling help on again. To collect the grades, you need to click each **GB** link (grade book). Neil is working on a better way to do this.

Competition: Students like to look good on this screen. Encourage the ones who do well and help those that are struggling. It's usually easy to spot the ones who need extra help.
